Preschool education promotes access to universal, joyful equitable learning opportunities for ensuring holistic development of all children between 3 - 6 years of age. These can be ensured by involving parents and teachers in providing an emotionally supportive, culturally rooted, child oriented stimulating learning environment. It aims at maximizing individual potential by creating strong foundations for lifelong learning through play and developmentally appropriate practices. It also intends to develop healthy attitude, good values, skills of critical thinking, creativity and socio emotional development.
